BCR No.1731

DO HEREBY RESOLVE

WHEREAS:


- A. Cheam First Nation has an inherent right to self-government which emanates from our people, culture and land and which is recognized and affirmed by section 35 of the *Constitution Act, 1982*.
- B. Cheam Members have voted in favour of the *Cheam First Nation Land Code* (the "Land Code") and *Indigenous and Northern Affairs Canada* has taken measures to transfer responsibility for land administration of the Cheam Reserve Lands to Cheam First Nation.
- C. Lands governed under a Land Code continue to be a reserve within the meaning of the *Indian Act* and are surveyed in accordance with the *Canada Lands Surveys Act*.
- D. Council has general authority under the *Land Code* to pass policies and procedures under section 6.5.
- E. Section 2.2.5 of *The National Standards for the Survey of Canada Lands* describes how to address "the remaining part of a parcel (called the parent parcel) after a surveyed parcel has been taken out of it."
- F. Council is concerned that if Lot designators for the remaining part of a parcel surveyed or to be subdivided parcels may become complex and cause uncertainty about the extent of the remaining parcel being described.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

Unless otherwise approved in writing by Council, Cheam will not permit the remaining part of a parcel (the parent parcel) to be designated on a survey plan or replacement title document with the parcel number of the parent parcel followed by the term "Remainder" or the abbreviation "Rem" as set out in Section 2.2.5, sub-section 50(a) of the *National Standards*. Instead, a new Parcel number is to be assigned as set out in Section 2.2.5, sub-section 50(b) of the *National Standards*.


