HEALTH TIPS FOR THE CHANGING SEASON

With the seasons changing, we want to remind everyone about the importance of staying informed and taking precautions against both COVID-19 and Tuberculosis (TB), two respiratory illnesses that can spread in our community. Your health and the health of those around you are our top priorities.

COVID-19 Awareness:

As the colder months approach, COVID-19 cases may rise. Please continue to follow these precautions to keep yourself and others safe:

- Wash hands frequently or use hand sanitizer.
- Stay home if you feel unwell or have COVID-like symptoms such as fever, cough, or loss of taste/smell.

Tuberculosis (TB) Awareness:

Tuberculosis is another serious illness that primarily affects the lungs. It's crucial to recognize the symptoms and take steps to prevent its spread: Symptoms of TB include a persistent cough (lasting more than 2 weeks), weight loss, night sweats, and fatigue. <u>Prevention tips:</u> Cover your mouth when coughing or sneezing, maintain proper ventilation in indoor spaces, and wash your hands regularly.

If you have symptoms or have been exposed to someone with TB, seek medical advice immediately. For more information on TB, visit the <u>First Nations Health Authority website</u>.



Protect Our Community:

Both COVID-19 and TB are preventable and treatable with early detection. By practicing good hygiene and seeking medical attention if you have symptoms, you help protect yourself and your family, friends, and neighbors.

SIGN UP FOR ELECTRONIC FUNDS TRANSFER (EFT)



Our goal is to slowly move all members on to electronic payments so that things like distribution, catering, and other benefits can be deposited right into your bank account. We know it will take time to get everyone switched over, so we are getting started now with the goal of having the majority switched over within one year. You can go into your bank and ask for the EFT form, or can download it from

NOTICE OF UPCOMING RAIL WORK CAUSING TEMPORARY CLOSURES ON CHEAM LAND

Between October 21-22nd the crossing at Mile 63.9 Yale sub/Old Yale Road (beside Fred Quipp's house) will be out of service for up to 36 hours. The alternate crossing to be used during this time is Mile 64.5 Yale Sub (Yale Road/Old Yale Rd, at the skatepark), as pictured below. This is safety-critical work and requires maintenance for both the safety of Cheam First Nation residents and the railroad. As good to be bours, CN has requested, and we have granted, permission for them to perfer a this to rk via our roadways.

There will be 12-20 workers on site plus equipment during 2 work blocks. CN will be utilizing Cheam's caterers to feed the crews and help bring more money back into the community.
