

SIGN UP FOR ELECTRONIC FUNDS TRANSFER (EFT)


NOTICE OF UPCOMING RAIL WORK CAUSING TEMPORARY CLOSURES ON CHEAM LAND

Between October 21-22nd the crossing at Mile 63.9 Yale sub/Old Yale Road (beside Fred Quipp's house) will be out of service for up to 36 hours. The alternate crossing to be used during this time is Mile 64.5 Yale Sub (Yale Road/Old Yale Rd, at the skatepark), as pictured below. This is safety-critical work and requires maintenance for both the safety of Cheam First Nation residents and the railroad. As good neighbours, CN has requested, and we have granted, permission for them to perform this work via our roadways.

There will be 12-20 workers on site plus equipment during 2 work blocks. CN will be utilizing Cheam's caterers to feed the crews and help bring more money back into the community.

More information will be provided closer to the work dates with specific times, and details. CN would like to extend their appreciation of our community's support.



Who Should Apply?

If you are a Stó:lō First Nation Artist, Crafter or Halq'emeylem Instructor who would like to earn an honorarium for a day or two and can produce quality kits to sell to participants, whom you will share your knowledge with, you should apply to CCEC.

Your activity may take 1 hour or 2 days to complete. For example – if your kit is to construct a cedar hat it may 2 days, but if it is a drumstick, it maybe 2 hours. Each participant will work at their pace and you will have up to 4 participants at your assigned table.

We suggest you create at least 50 kits for easy workshop activities and about 25 kits for more challenging workshops. This should be adequate if you plan to be at the event for the weekend.
