

Notice Of Upcoming Work


Re: unofficial shooting range under BC Hydro right-of-way, within the gravel extraction pit

The shooting range at this location will no longer be safe or permitted as the site has been mobilized as of January 13th, 2025. Fill work to stabilize the banks and restore ground elevations for future use will begin March 3rd, 2025.

The site is currently under the care and control of Copper Raven Capital, with the prime contractor being RAM Engineering.


